SUBJECT: Mary K. Browne Tournament Results

THE MARY K. BROWNE TOURNAMENT honors a women's golf and tennis champion. Ms. Browne won three consecutive US Women's Tennis Championships from 1912-14, and was the US Women's Doubles Champion with Helen Wills in 1921. In 1924, Ms. Browne was the runner-up in the US Women's Amateur Championship, and in 1931, she won the Women's Ohio State Amateur Championship. Ms. Browne also served in the American Red Cross Foreign Service in World War II. She won the CWGA District Championship in 1931, 1932, 1934, and 1935. This tournament, always held at Kirtland Country Club, is a 36-hole two-day low net event open to players with a handicap index through 19.1. A maximum field of 60 players competes with full handicap. The winner receives a trophy, donated in 1952. Flight winners receive certificates.
